The Disciplinary Committee investigated the Erste Liga EL 62 (Sport Club Csíkszereda - DVTK Jegesmedvék) where in the 40th minutes Colin Doyle (DVTK Jegesmedvék) penalized 5+20 minutes for slashing.

IIHF RULE 61 SLASHING

Slashing is the act of a Player swinging their stick at an opponent, whether contact is made or not. "Non-aggressive" stick contact to the pant or front of the shin pads, should not be penalized as slashing. Any forceful or powerful chop with the stick on an opponent's body, the opponent's stick, or on or near the opponent's hands that, in the judgment of the Referee, is not an attempt to play the puck, shall be penalized as slashing.

IIHF 61.6. DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

If deemed appropriate, Supplementary Discipline can be applied by the Proper Authorities at their discretion.

The Committee made the following conclusions:

The DVTK Jegesmedvék player hit his opponent several times with his stick, and acted as an aggressor. The referee's decisive intervention prevented further unsportsmanlike scenes.

The Disciplinary Committee, considering the all the circumstances of the case, upholds the penalty imposed by the referees, and doesn't impose any further sanctions against the player.
